City Haul Acceptable Materials RESIDENTIAL HOUSEHOLD ITEMS ONLY

RECYCLABLES: Paper, cans, plastic, glass, electronics, metal (*recyclables must be pre-separated from trash*)

YARD WASTE: Limbs no longer than 4 feet and no larger than 4 inches in diameter. Wood chipper on site—free mulch may be available. first come-first serve. Load your own truck.

TRASH: Household waste, junk

ELECTRONICS RECYCLING: Old computers, TV's, cell phones, anything with a cord.

APPLIANCES & CAR BATTERIES will be accepted for this City Haul.

What's not allowed:

Tires, wet paint (dried paint is OK), toxic or hazardous materials, commercial waste, fluorescents, light bulbs & household batteries. (Some items may be taken to the County Landfill)

CITY MANAGER'S NEWS

Over the last six months, City Staff have been working hard to achieve the City Council's goals and objectives. I would like to go over a few of those achievements.

New City Website - In August 2023, the City's new website was launched. The website offers better options to find out about things going on in the City, upcoming meeting agendas, make payments, apply for permits and other services. Furthermore, I have started producing a weekly update that is in both video and written form.

Vision Trinity Comprehensive Land Use Plan - In August 2023, the City Council approved and adopted the new "Vision Trinity" Comprehensive Land Use Plan. This project was completed over a fourteen-month period. The Comprehensive Land Use Plan will serve as a guide for the City's future growth for the next 20 years. On a routine basis, City Staff will review the document to see what changes or updates may be needed. You can view it on our website. www.trinity-nc.gov

Randolph County Sheriff's Office Substation - In the Fiscal Year 2022 - 2023 Budget, the City Council approved funds for the renovation of the old City Hall to become a Substation for the Randolph County Sheriff's Office. This project was funded by a local funding allocation from the North Carolina General Assembly. The project should be completed by the end of October and the Sheriff's Department staff should be operating out of this location by November 2023.

ATTENTION ALL PROPERTY OWNERS CONNECTED TO CITY SEWER

DO NOT DUMP COOKING OILS OR GREASE DOWN YOUR SINK DRAIN OR TOILET!

Fats, Oils and Grease (FOG) Ordinance Background:

Sanitary sewer overflows are a serious environmental problem and a violation of the Clean Water Act. A large percentage of sewer overflows and backups are caused by misuse of the collection system by the public. **Fats, Oils and Grease (FOG)** can solidify in the pipe and cause sewer backups. The Federal Government through the State of North Carolina is requiring utilities to meet minimum operation standards through a permit process. The Collection System Permit requires a FOG Ordinance to address this problem. Operating at or above this minimum standard provides some protection from fines and liability for property damage.



City of Trinity is limited to 24% impervious area in your property before water must be treated. For many properties, this may be the solution to adding more impervious area (pool area, addition to home,
